White

French Regional

2003 Vin de Pays d'Oc, Sauvignon £4.50

Classic herbaceous Sauvignon Blanc nose. Rich citrus Ocharacter on the palate, zesty acidity and a lingering finish.

2003 Vin de Pays d'Oc, Syrah Rosè £4.50

An easy-to-drink Rose with an orangey pink hue. The wine has a slightly smoky nose, which reveals the perfumed spice of Syrah. On the palate the wine shows lovely fresh, fruit such as raspberry, blackcurrant and redcurrant and it has a dry, crisp finish. A perfect 'Summer Pudding' wine.

2003 Vin de Pays d'Oc, Chardonnay £4.50

Ripe and aromatic pear with a touch of fresh peach, fresh and zingy in the mouth starting off with gummy mineral tones then getting fuller and peachier, quite concentrated fruit flavour but balanced by crisp acidity.

Vin de Table, Cuvée Jean Paul 100cl £5.25

A fresh, dry white made from quality grapes sourced from Vin de Pays des Cotes de Gascogne. Delicious, fresh, fragrant nose followed by crisp green fruit on the palate and lively acidity.

NV Muscat de Rivesaltes, Domaine de Forca Real 50cl £6.95

Pale, golden yellow colour with an aromatic, perfumed nose. On the palate the grapey, orange blossom Muscat character shines through with weight and powerful honeyed fruit and soft mouth feel. Good concentration and a long ripe finish.

2001/2 Ch de Pennautier, Chardonnay, Cabardes £7.95

This Chardonnay is fine and elegant but also concentrated with powerful aromas of oak, pineapple, vanilla, passion fruit and dried apricots; quite fat in the mouth with rich toasty and stirred creamy lees flavours mixing with more of those tropical fruits, then good length and balance.

Alsace

1999/2000 Gewurztraminer, Cave de Turckheim £7.50

Pale golden colour with perfumed aromatics of lychees, rose petals and spice. A fantastic wine with great complexity, full bodied with spice and intense fruit on the finish.

Bordeaux

2002 Ch. Haut Mirambet £6.25

A crisp, dry white Bordeaux with plenty of fruit.

2000/1 Sauternes, Dulong £11.95

Rich, golden yellow colour with a powerful and racy bouquet of beeswax and honey. Unctuous, well-balanced and persistent in the mouth with fig and apricot flavours. Ideal with foie gras, blue cheeses, white and dark chocolate or dishes made with honey.

Burgundy

- 2002 Sauvignon de St Bris, Felix £6.95
An elegant Sauvignon with a floral nose and some nice apple and citrus characters on the palate.
- 2002 Bourgogne Aligote, Domaine Felix £6.95
This Aligote is lightly aromatic with pungent greengage and leafy vegetable edge, mineral and nuts; a little fuller and creamier on the palate balanced by characteristic crisp acidity and further mineral length.
- 2001/2 Macon-Lugny les Genièvres, Louis Latour 75 cl £7.95
One of the top white wines from the Maconnais, from a highly reputed producer. Smooth, flavoursome and with excellent structure.
- 1999 St Veran Domaine des Valanges, Paquet £8.75
Fruity and clean, ripe lemony Chardonnay from Southern Burgundy.
- 1998 Chablis Duplessis £10.95
Fresh and un-oaked classic Chablis, lean and well-defined.
- 1999 Chablis 1er Cru, Montmains, J-P Droin 75cl £14.50
Famous Premier Cru Chablis from producer with international following; lightly oaked, with body and depth of flavour
- 1999 Chassagne Montrachet, Bachelet £19.50
Round ripe and classy white Burgundy from one of Burgundy's classic vineyards.
- 2001 Meursault, M Lafarge £24.95
Buttery and rich white Burgundy with bite, from one of the area's most famous producers.
- 2000 Puligny Montrachet, J-C Bachelet, 1er cru £24.95
Old vines and skilful winemaking produce a wine with a flavour combining lemon, honey and vanilla.

Loire

- 2003 Sauvignon de Touraine, Dom du Pre Baron £6.25
A classic gooseberry, grassy nose with crisp lemony acidity on the palate and a touch of minerality providing a clean, dry finish.
- 2001 Quincy, Domaine Mardon £8.95
Made from the Sauvignon Blanc grape grown in the middle of the Loire valley, this wine is crisp and fresh with good acidity, appley fruit and a long lingering finish. A terrific alternative to the better known Sancerre.
- 2001 Sancerre, Domaine de La Garenne, N-Reverdy £10.95
Fresh and fragrant chalky gooseberry Sauvignon from a leading single domaine.

Australian

- 2003/4 Windowrie "The Mill Chardonnay" £6.50
This Mill Chardonnay is a brilliant pale colour and has aromas of melon, peach fruit and subtle oak. The palate displays ripe melon and peach and refined oak. Soft mouth feel with a crisp acid finish.

Italian

2003 Cattarrato, Terrale £5.75
Terrale Catarratto is a white wine made from native Sicilian grapes. It has typical soft nectarine fruit flavours with an elegant but assertive fruit character and long finish. Good with chicken, pasta and fish.

2002/3 Pinot Grigio, Terrazza della Luna £6.75
Straw yellow colour. Clean and floral nose with fruity notes hinting at banana and pineapple. Nice white fruit on the palate with fresh acidity on the finish.

New Zealand

2003/4 Mount Cass, Sauvignon Blanc £8.95
Aromatic white with elegant lime and juicy gooseberry flavours on the palate plus a crisp, mineral finish.

South African

2000 Paarl Heights Chenin Blanc, Boland Wynkelder £4.50
A crisp dry wine, with lingering flavours of guava & tropical fruit.

2001 Cape Bay, Sauvignon Blanc £6.25
This tangy, racy, dry wine shows fresh tropical fruit flavours, a clean dry finish and is delicious with seafood and salads.

Sparkling Wine

Cray Brut, Cremant de la Loire £7.50
Subtle, floral and lightly honeyed nose, followed by richer and round intensity of fruit and balanced with fine and elegant acidity. Mousse is fine and elegant.

Cray Rosé, Cremant de la Loire £7.50
Light and elegant with tangy soft fruits and nutty/almond flavours. Nice and mouth-watering due to subtle yeasty lees characters and fine acidity; perfect for those who say they don't like that aged and very dry champagne taste.

Veuve de Bomonde Brut, Cuve Close £5.50
Simple but attractive light fizz with nutty freshness and elegant notes of citrus and white flowers. Goes down very easily.

Champagne

Krug Grand Cuvée £72.50
Krug remains at the summit of the Champagne-making art, each year producing outstanding wines with no concession to commercial pressures. It is a heavily Pinot-dominated blend, still using wines fermented in oak barrels. A bouquet wonderfully creamy, leading to a magical combination of richness and balance on the palate. The long, lingering finish is both nutty and toasty, always ending with a final flourish of freshness, leaving one longing for more.

Veuve Clicquot 1995 £34.50
An outstanding vintage Champagne from the historic "widows" Champagne house on Reims.

Mansard, Cuvée Victoire, 1996/8	£28.95
Veuve Clicquot NV, Yellow Label Brut Well-known for both its full-bodied, biscuity style and its consistency, the success of this famous brand continues to grow and grow. A black grape dominated blend, using 70% Pinot Noir and Meunier together with 30% Chardonnay.	£25.50
Canard-Duchene NV, Brut Rosé A salmon colour, with beautiful pearly bubbles and fine mousse. Intense fresh fruit aromas of cherry, with mineral and toasted characteristics. A powerful full-bodied wine yet surprisingly silky because of its maturity, with flavours reminiscent of crystallised fruit. Canard-Duchêne Brut Rosé is a pleasant accompaniment for red meat or red berry desserts.	£20.75
Canard-Duchene NV Brut Intense fresh fruit aromas, mingle with the fragrance of fresh brioche on the palate to give a delightful Champagne. Ideal as an aperitif or as an accompaniment to white meat.	£19.75
Mansard Blanc des Blancs, Gd Cru 1994	£21.95
Mansard NV Brut – MAGNUM	£38.95
Mansard NV Brut Blended with the three main champagne grape varieties Pinot Noir gives elegance and length, Pinot Meunier gives body weight and Chardonnay contributes aroma and finesse. There is a good amount of bottle age on the brut non-vintage, making this a very attractive and enjoyable champagne.	£19.95
Chimere NV A quality dry Champagne with lemony, biscuity flavours, fine bubbles and a touch of ageing.	£16.50

Red Wine

French Regional

2002 Grenache Rouge, Vin de Pays d'Oc Wild blackberry fruit is prominent on the nose with hints of cinnamon spice, soft and warm jammy fruit to follow with supple tannins making it an easy drinker.	£4.50
2003 Merlot, Vin de Pays d'Oc Rich, vibrant and aromatic wine with soft plummy flavours, full jammy fruit and a nice tannic bite.	£4.50
2003 Cabernet Sauvignon, Vin de pays d'Oc Ripe blackcurrant and wild berry fruit on the nose with a hint of grassy herbs. Smooth palate with full black fruits and well-integrated tannins.	£4.50
2003 Syrah, Vin de Pays d'Oc A full-flavoured, rustic Syrah plenty of spice and ripe damson fruit and a nice 'meaty' concentration.	£4.50
Vin de Table, Cuvée Jean Paul 100cl A delicious medium to full-bodied red with luscious plum and strawberry fruit on the palate. Soft, fruity and very drinkable.	£5.25
2002 Corbières, Domaine des Deux Anes Deep ruby colour with plum and cherry aromas and underlying gamey and 'garrigue' elements. The wine evolves in the glass giving raisin and nutty characters, and a soft fleshy and supple finish.	£5.95

- 2000/1 Ch de Pennautier, rouge, Cabardes** £7.95
Full bodied and rustic with smoky aromas of blackcurrant and mulberry mixed with hints of spice, menthol and cocoa. Rich and chewy with earthy, ripe fruit and a hint of oak. Delicious!
- 1999/2000 L'Esprit de Pennautier, Cabardes** £16.50
L'Esprit is the crème de la crème from the Chateau, a full-bodied and complex red that will age and improve for more than ten years.
- 2001 Corbières Domaine des Deux Anes, L'Enclos** £8.95
Complex aromas of blackberries, plums, spicy pepper and gingerbread. Generous palate, dense yet elegant with with some delicacy and elegance, supple tannins and an exquisite perfume that just gets better in the glass.
- 2000 Faugères, Gilbert Alquier** £8.75
Warm and full flavoured, made from the classic Southern French grape varieties of Grenache, Syrah & Mourvedre, embodies the appeal of the great wines of the Rhone at a very attractive price.
- Bordeaux**
- 2000 Chateau Leon, Bordeaux Superieur** £6.95
A delicious young claret, full of soft red fruit with good balance and length. This wine is only lightly filtered to retain the maximum flavour and should result in a light, harmless deposit in the bottom of the bottle.
- 1999 Ch Mayne-Vieil, Fronsac** £7.50
Wonderful leafy/earthy aromas with tart curranty red fruits and riper plum notes on the palate. Long, attractive finish.
- 1999 Ch Jupille Carillon, St Emilion** £9.95
Fruity and clean merlot dominated claret, un-oaked, soft and approachable.
- 1999 Ch La Croix des Moines, Lalande de Pomerol** £13.95
Pomerol in style, rich and merlot based, raised in oak casks with great depth of flavour.
- 1995 Ch Marsac Seguineau, Margaux** £16.75
This Cru Bourgeois has, for a Margaux, an unusually high percentage of merlot in the blend, making it darkly coloured with firm tannins and an intense richness. Rated as one of the best Margaux Cru Bourgeois by Robert Parker, this wine, which is perfect for drinking now, also offers excellent value for money.
- 1991 Ch Vincent, Margaux** £21.00
A small vineyard within the confines of Chateau Palmer produces this stylish Margaux; one of Bordeaux's great secrets.
- 1999 Ch Durfort Vivens, Margaux** £22.50
The 1999 vintage was highly successful in Margaux, this wine is very ripe with blackcurrant undertones from its Cabernet Sauvignon. Classed growth claret of great distinction at an affordable price.
- 1998 Ch Meyney, St Estephe** £25.00
A lovely nose of jammy black cherries and toasty oak. It has sweet ripe flavours, is medium to full bodied and has impressive concentration.
- 1998 Ch Cissac – MAGNUM** £37.50
Very dense and opaque purple/crimson. Closed, but more fragrant, sweeter nose. Good blueberry fruit, quite aromatic with violet scents but also meaty notes. Good, rich blackberry fruit on the palate and very drying tannins.

Burgundy

- 1999 Bourgogne AC Pinot Noir, Louis Latour** £7.75
 Typicity is of great importance for these wines. 100% Pinot Noir wines from the lesser-known yet well placed vineyards of the southern Côte-d'Or are harmoniously united with small lots of superior Santenay or Auxey-Duresses giving an overall result which is startlingly reminiscent of a fine Côte de Beaune wine. This Cuvée Latour Rouge has a beautiful, regal red colour, a full, rich bouquet and ample body, distinctive Pinot Noir fruit, robust tannin and subtle wood overtones together in exemplary balance climaxing in a long finish.
- 2001 Fleurie** £7.95
 Ripe red fruit flavours with hints of strawberry and morello cherries. Full and firm grip on finish.
- 2001 Hautes Cotes de Beaune, Rollin** £9.75
 Aromatic, fresh pure Pinot Noir, with red berry fruit flavours, grown on hillside slopes above Corton in heart of Burgundy.
- 1998 Santenay 1er Cru Les Gravières, Colin Deleger** £16.25
 Classic Red Burgundy with backbone and concentration of flavour from one of Burgundy's new wave of producers.
- 1998 Blagny 1er Cru la Genelotte** £18.50
 Careful winemaking produces a Pinot Noir with finesse and delicacy from a well situated vineyard between Puligny Montrachet and Volnay.
- 2000 Vosne Romanee, 1er Cru Les Chaumes, Lamarche** £29.95
 Pinot Noir from a highly regarded vineyard in a vintage that produced very attractive and aromatic early drinking wines with ripe berry fruit flavours.

Rhone

- 2002 Crozes Hermitage, Cave de Tain, 75 cl** £7.99
 Aromatic, spicy fruit on the nose, followed by raspberries, liquorice and pepper on the palate. Medium-bodied, soft and rounded.
- 2002 Crozes Hermitage, Cave de Tain, 37.5 cl** £4.25
- 2000 Chateauneuf-du-Pape, Chante Cigale** £13.95
 The wine has lots of warm red fruit and damson aromas, with cinnamon, spices and jam but also concentration on the palate; then liquoricey richness and elegance to finish.

Australian

- 2002/3 Windowrie "The Mill" Shiraz** £6.50
 A delicate medium-bodied Shiraz with aromas of berries, white pepper and sawdust. The palate shows raspberries and sweet fruit with soft tannins on the finish.

Italian

- 1999 Chianti, Riccardo Falchini** £7.25
 Well made and pure Sangiovese from an individual producer, fruity and unmistakably Italian in style.
- 1997/8 Teroldego Rotaliano, Terrazze della Luna** £6.75
 Spicy fruity nose with overtones of raspberry and banana, quite dry with light grip and good length balanced nicely by tangy liquoricey flavours.

South African

2001 Paarl Heights Red, Boland Wynkelder £4.50

A soft, medium bodied red providing explosive ripe berry fruit with a touch of pepper and spice.

Cape bay, Cabernet Sauvignon £7.25

Picked at optimum ripeness, both varietals are fermented separately in stainless steel tanks, and then left for 10 days post fermentation maceration to give ripe, supple fruit flavours. The result is a classic blend of these two noble varietals, showing complex berry fruits.

2001/2 Clos Malverne, Pinotage £7.50

The wine has a dark plum colour. On the nose it shows full ripe fruit with plums, berries, spices and oak overtones. On the palate it is rich, fruity and well balanced with lingering flavours of tangy berries.

Spanish

Rioja Beronia, barrel fermented £7.99

A fruity bouquet and aromas of liquorice mixed with smoky shades of mocca. Gentle but complex on the palate. Ideal for a wine with the sensation of enjoying something different.

Chile

Torreon de Parredes, Cabernet Sauvignon Reserve £7.95

Deep brilliant ruby colour with dark notes. The nose is full of red and ripe fruits with vanilla, menthol, coffee and dry plums. The palate is a mouthful of firm tannins that will ensure a long life for this reserve wine.
